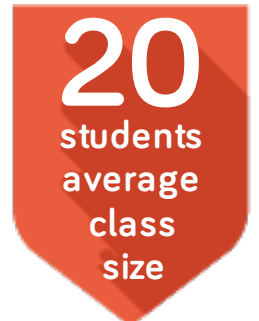
## Accreditation

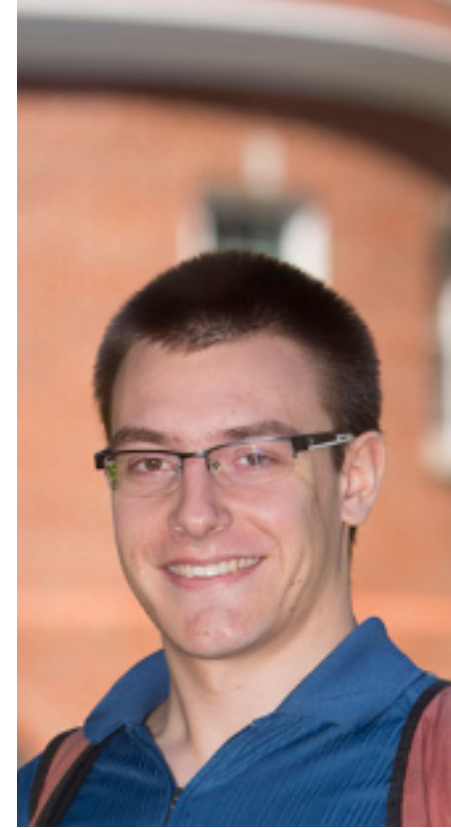

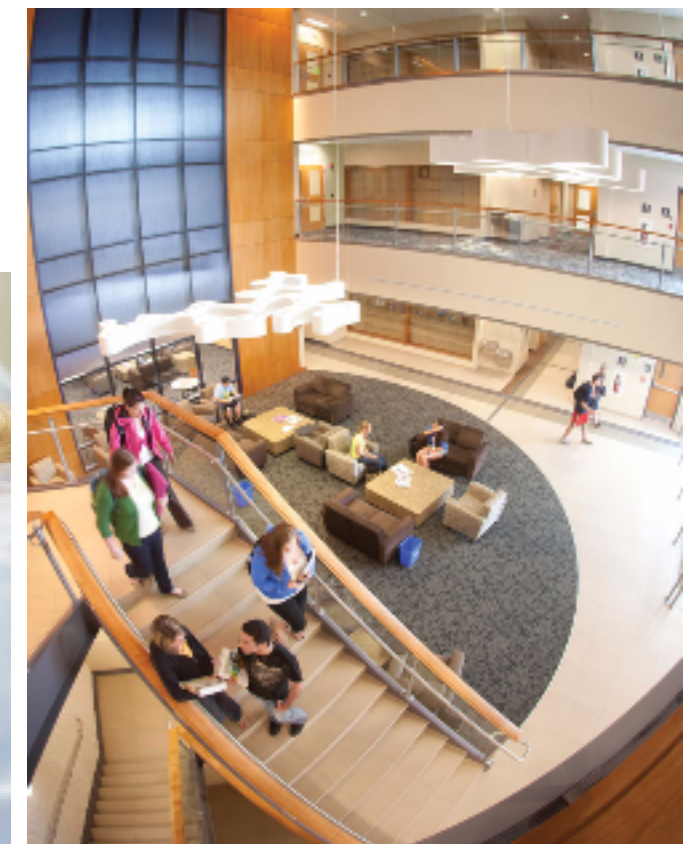

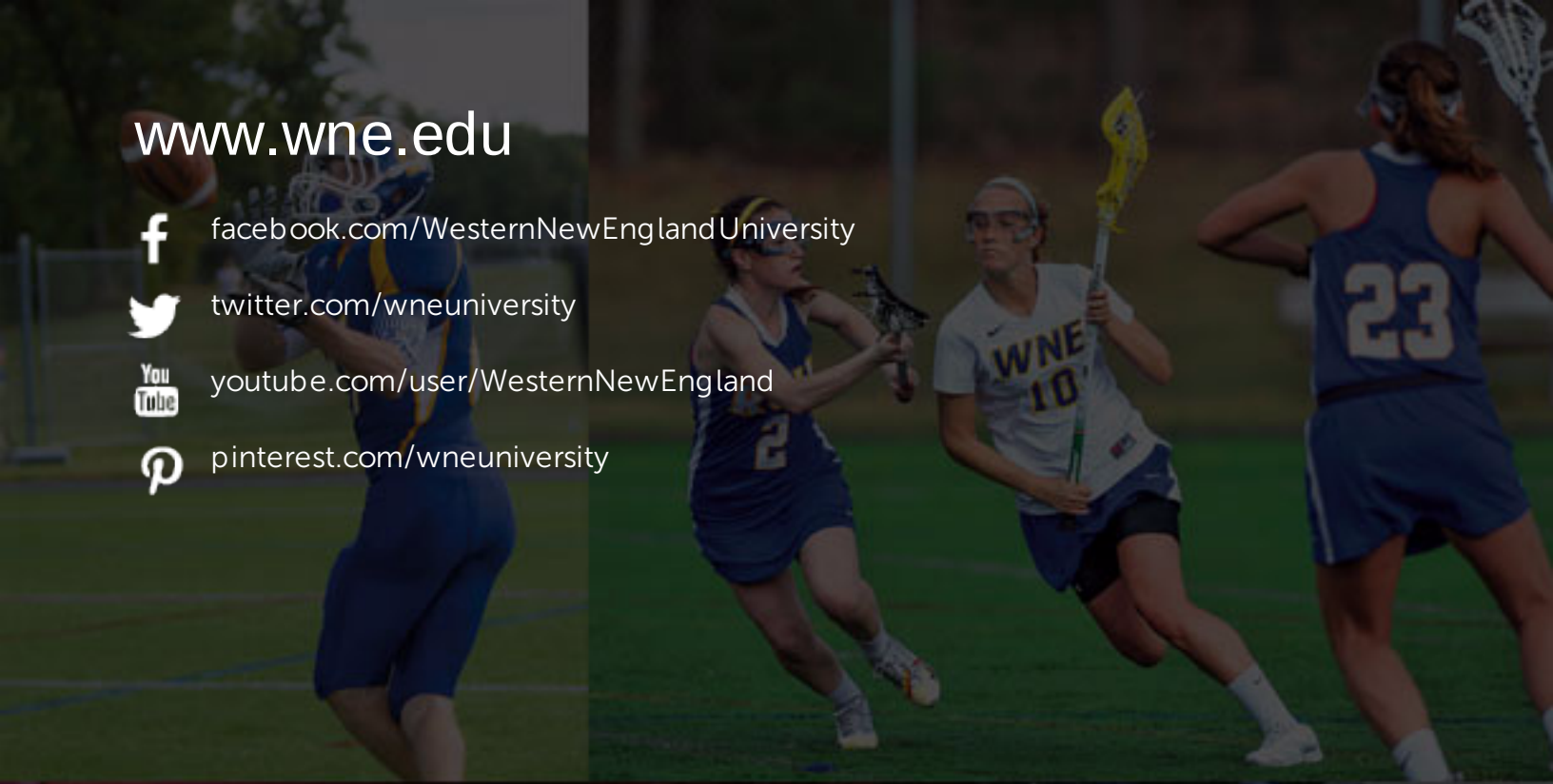
