Bridge university partners offer a variety of oncampus living arrangements including doubleoccupancy dormitories, suites, and apartment-style residences. First-year students are encouraged to live on-campus with their classmates. Living on-campus is a good way to get involved in university activities, meet new people, and to make new friends.

## Off-campus

All of our university partners either offer their own off-campus housing or assist international students in securing independent off-campus housing. Living off-campus is usually recommended for older, graduate-level students or for students with spouses and children. Living off-campus usually requires taking public transportation to class.

## **Host Families**

In some cases, Bridge is able to secure host family accommodations. Students attending BridgeEnglish in Denver generally live with host families, as well as younger students who may come to study short-term. Living with a host family can provide extra support, and encourages students to practice their English at all times.
